### **FALLS OF GLOMACH**

The Falls of Glomach is one of the highest waterfalls in Britain, with a drop of 113m (370ft), set in a steep narrow cleft in remote Highland country. It can be reached only on foot - the best approach is from the Dorusduain car park (Forest Enterprise) two miles off the north section of the loop in the old A87.
